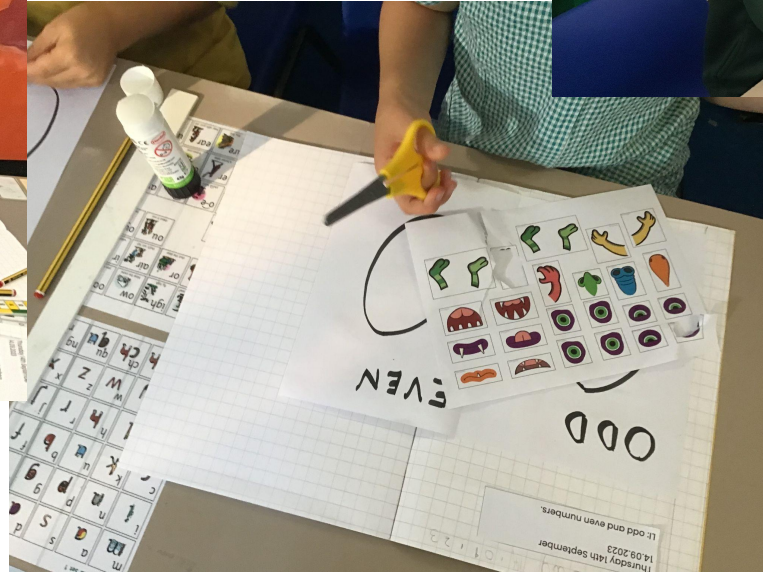
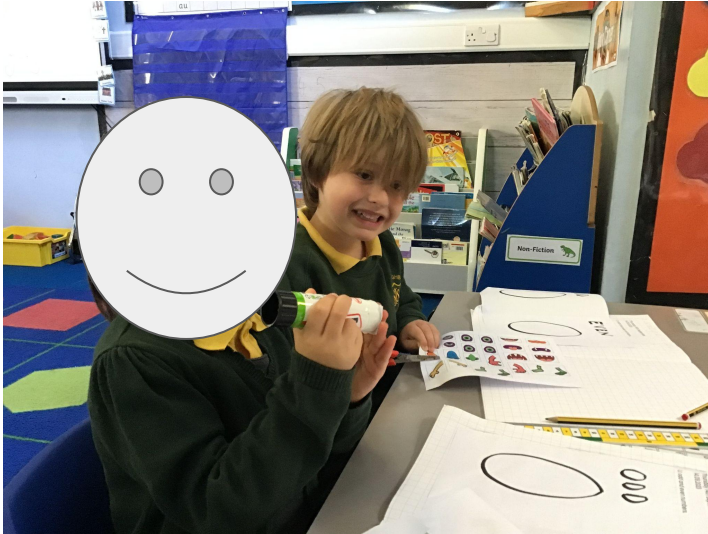
Reception News
