

## Reception News




We are continuing to develop our knowledge of letters and sounds and are working hard on our letter formation.


## Year 3 News

Year 6 have been practicing their flute and other instruments for our christmas performance next week. We are very excited to perform to the school and hope everyone enjoys it.










## Sports
