Reception News




Reception class have been exploring our big question in R.E, 'What is so special about Easter?'

We thought about the special job that the donkey had and learned about the events of Palm Sunday.


Then, we used our class resources to build Jerusalem and re-enact Palm Sunday.




Year 4 News


















Year 5 News




Year 6 News


