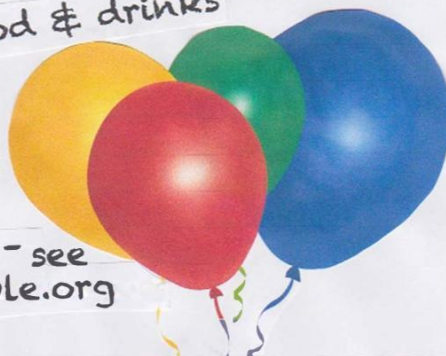

## Year 3

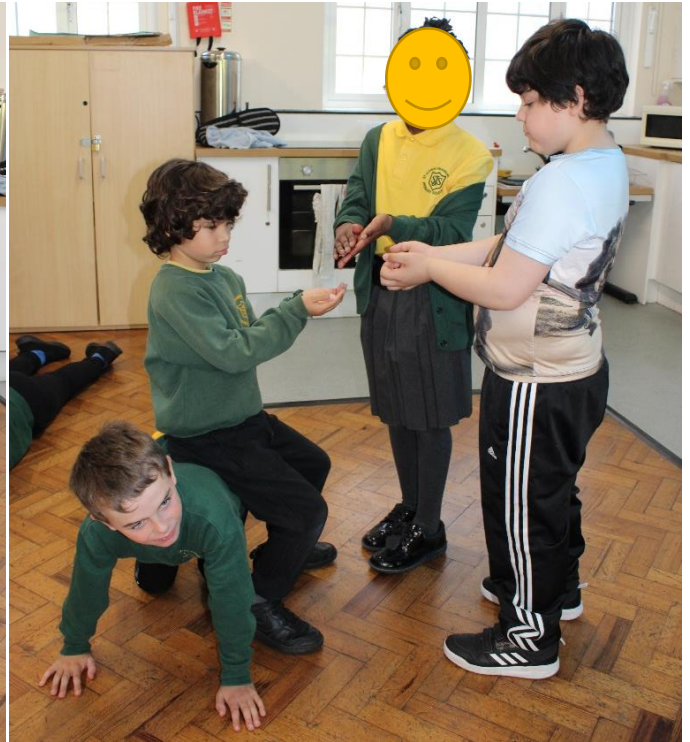

## Year 5

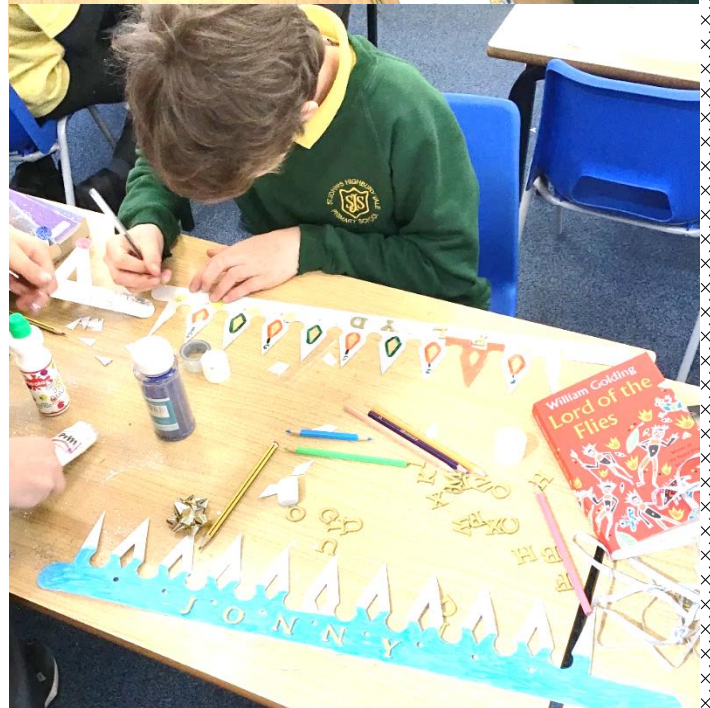
To celebrate the King's Coronation, Year 5 decorated their own crowns using a variety of materials - glitter being the star of the show!
