

Look at our radishes! They were only tiny seeds a few weeks ago. We had a great time harvesting them and then tasting them.






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

Then we got into character as villagers from the Yao tribe and debated how we should hide our Village to keep us safe. Everyone took part and we had a great time arguing our points.


Year 4
