## Year 1

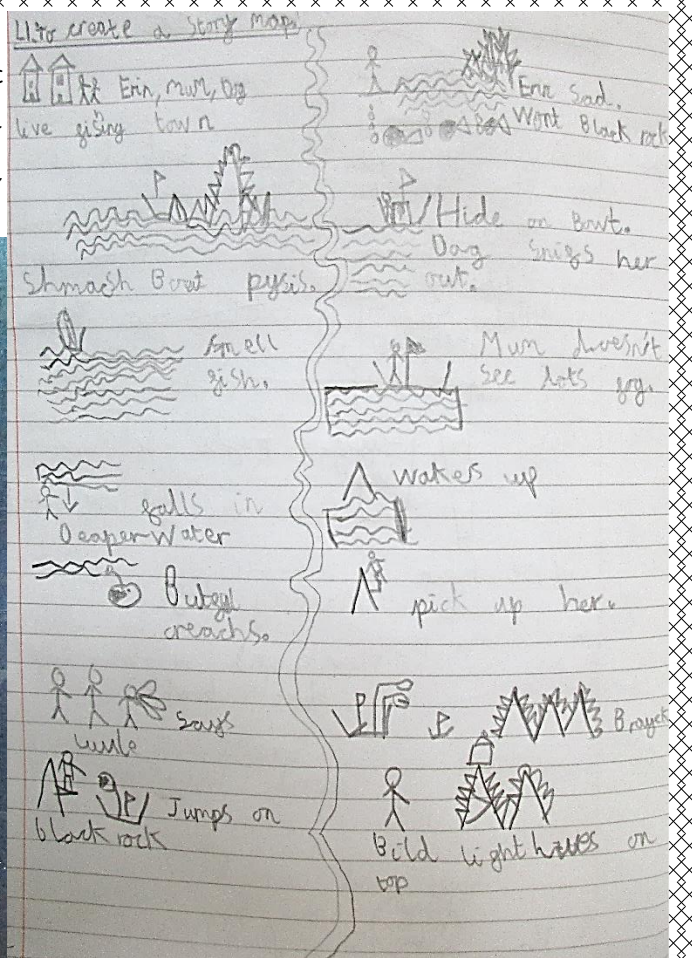
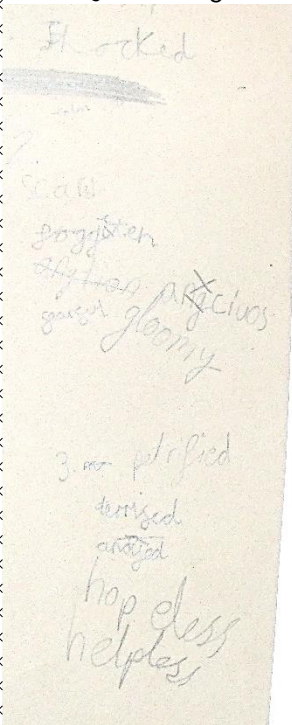
We have new, furry members of our class this week- Say hello to Bounce and Bobyn!





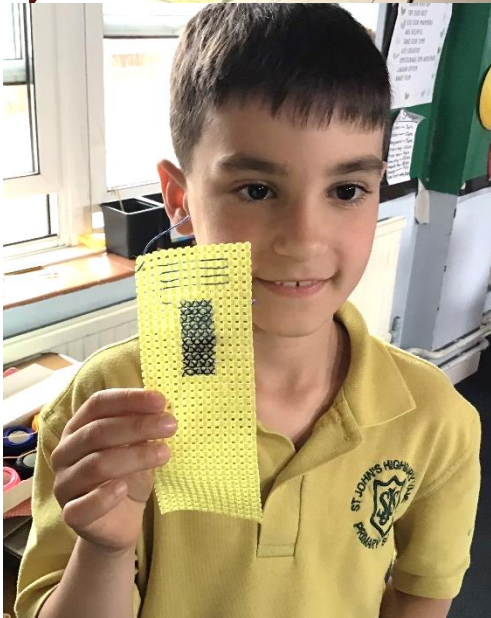
## Year 2
