We said a prayer for peace in the future and talked about the poppy symbol. Then we had a go at making and painting our own poppies.
















This week in Year 1, we have been learning about Remembrance day and what it means to different people. We created our very own Poppy wreath and wrote some notes to those who served our country.







Year 4 News

This week the children were learning about why Remembrance Day is celebrated every year.


In class children wrote prayers, poems, made poppies and looked at the roles different people played.
