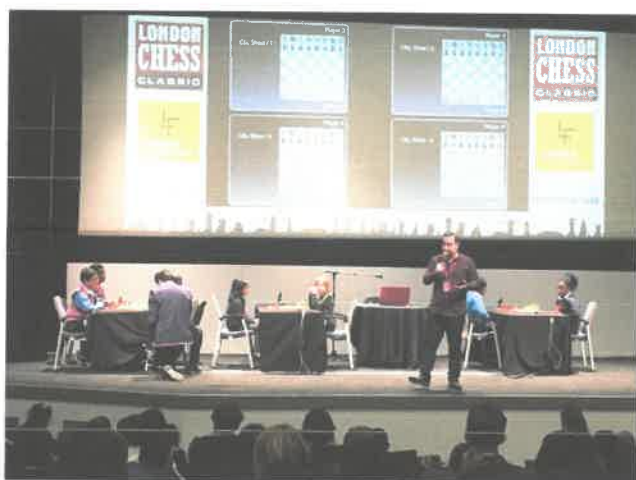
Christmas Tree Collection
