^{**}Tuesday afterschool music club – year 2/3

Emma Harding has been teaching music, recorder and flute to various year groups at our school since 2019. She also leads weekly singing assemblies, and choir for year 4,5,6. A note from Emma:

'I am really excited to be able to offer an after-school music club for children in year 2 and 3 starting in September – Tuesdays 15:30-16:30. We will be building on what we learn in class, and I would encourage those children to sign up who really enjoy the songs, games and activities we do. My teaching is based on the Kodály approach which emphasises an experience first approach – in other words, learning to feel and hear the music prior to (or alongside) tackling the technical difficulties of an instrument. Sessions will be fun, creative and complementary to our in-school music lessons. Spaces will be limited, so please sign up soon'.

** Wednesday afterschool music centre – year 4/5/6 – location: City of London Academy Highbury Grove Children from year 4-6 are invited to join an after-school centre on Wednesday afternoons lead by a team of tutors from Music Education Islington. Our music teacher Emma is a part of the music centre and would like to encourage children to attend who wish to further their flute or trumpet playing. Children who learn other instruments outside of school are also more than welcome to join on their chosen instrument. At the music centre, children will receive a small group instrumental lesson, play as part of a large ensemble and sing in a choir. They will meet children from different schools (primary and secondary) across Islington and receive tuition from a great team of professional musicians.

(Please note, children in year 2/3 are invited to attend the after-school music club at school on Tuesday afternoons before joining the music centre in year 4).
