Dear Parents & Carers,

This week it has become obvious that the rise in Covid cases across the UK, is also very apparent within Islington too. We currently have a number of children and parents self-isolating, and are referring more families than we have previously to carry out PCR tests. Only last week, I was informed that bubbles have had to close in neighboring schools, and this is extremely close to home.

Following on from this information and having carried out a risk assessment, we have concluded that unfortunately, we have to cancel the summer socials, which were recently arranged and organized by FOSJ. It is a real shame that we will not get the opportunity to come together as a community, and raise much needed funds for the school, however, I have to put the safety of the community first and foremost. Of the numerous jobs I have to fulfil by the end of term, my most important one is to keep the school open for all children by doing all I can to keep our environment safe. I have spoken with staff about being extra vigilant for the next four week with sanitization, and the use of PPE. I have reiterated that face masks/coverings need to be worn at the schools gates at drop off in the morning and collection at the end of the school day. Please can I ask that you support the school in doing the same and wear face coverings, unless exempt, and following current government guidelines to keep our school community safe.

Conewood Street

A reminder that although Conewood Street is now a school street, and is closed to the public during drop off and pick up times, it is still a road. Children have been seen dashing up and down the middle of the road on scooters before and after school, which is not safe. Residents are still allowed to drive on this road at any time. I have spoken to the children about this in school, please can I ask that you reiterate this message at home too.
