

English:

We will focus on stories with familiar settings and will be developing the following skills:

- drama (hot seating, roleplaying etc- give structure for characteristics and Qs)
- identifying the beginning, middle and end in narrative
- Retelling the story: focusing on who is in the event, where events take place and what happens in each event
- Using story language, sentence patterns and sequencing words to organise events.

Maths:

We will focus on place value, addition and subtraction and shape and will be developing the following skills;

- Count forwards and backwards, read and write numbers to 20 in numerals and words.
- Given a number, identify one more or one less.
- Identify and represent numbers using objects and pictorial representations and use the language of: equal to, more than, less than (fewer), most, least.
- Represent and use number bonds and related subtraction facts.
- Recognise and name common 2-D and 3-D shapes.

Time:

Use language relating to dates; days weeks, months and years.
Tell the time to the hour and half past the hour.
