

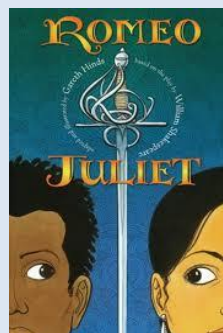
English:

Writing: This half term our literacy lessons will be focused around Romeo & Juliet. We will look closely at the language of Shakespeare and create our own play scripts, poems, creative and persuasive writing. There will be discrete spelling and grammar lessons each week.

Reading: In addition to our play script, the children will be encouraged to read for pleasure as often as possible. They will have regular guided reading sessions to teach a range of reading comprehension skills from a variety of texts.

Books and Reading Records should be brought to school daily.
