2. Paul Klee: a) Born in Switzerland in 1879 b) Liked to use lots of colours and lines c) Abstract artist	
3. Abstract art: a) Mainly uses colours, shapes, lines and marks b) The artist shows their interpretation of something c) It might appear as an unrealistic image	
4. Lines: a) Straight – a line in the same direction that connects two points b) Curved – a smooth line that curves in different directions c) Zig-zag – a line that has lots of short, sharp turns
