Assessment

This week you would have received your child's report and you will have the opportunity to discuss it with the class teacher. If your child has dropped a grade in maths please try not to worry, this is due to curriculum coverage. At the end of the spring term, children will have covered approximately 60% of the maths curriculum. According to our assessment system, children working at the expected level will have achieved 30 - 80% of the national curriculum statements. Children working at greater depth will have achieved more than 80% of the national curriculum statements. Considering that only 60% of the maths curriculum has been covered at this time, it is possible that children who were at greater depth in the autumn term are now as expected in the spring term.
