## **Pick up after clubs**

Clubs finish at 4:30 pm, and as you are aware, we run a number of after-school clubs. We have noticed that some parents are arriving by car to collect their children, but remain in their vehicles while the children come out to them. Parking opposite the school and calling children to the car is a dangerous practice that causes traffic congestion, blocks the road, and creates a significant safety hazard for children by obscuring their visibility. Parents are strongly encouraged to park a minimum of 5 minutes away from the school to reduce congestion and pollution, and to ensure the safety of all children and pedestrians.
