Developing independence

This week, the children have been busy writing. Every child was given the same stimulus and asked to write their own story. While no adult support was provided during the writing process, children with SEND were given appropriate scaffolds to help them access the task successfully.

We are doing this as part of our ongoing work to develop independent and resilient learners. One of our key focuses this year is ensuring that all children are able to engage with their learning confidently, without waiting for adult support. To achieve this, teachers are using a range of strategies to help pupils build good learning habits, take ownership of their work, and develop the confidence to persevere when faced with challenges.

You can really help with this at home by encouraging your child to have a go before asking for help, praising their effort rather than just the outcome, and giving them opportunities to solve problems or complete tasks independently. Small steps—like packing their own bag, checking their homework, or practising a skill on their own—help build confidence and resilience that carry through into their learning at school.
