Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope you have had a lovely and productive week. The children have worked incredibly hard on their assessments and are really beginning to show just how much they have learned. Their focus and determination have been wonderful to see, and we are very proud of the progress they are making.

Reading for Pleasure

It has been a pleasure to see so many children at the book fair and to hear them discussing which book they want to buy. I don't know if you've seen the article this week about MPs launching a new inquiry to explore how to keep the joy of reading alive. There is a worrying decline in the number of children reading for pleasure.

A survey by the National Literacy Trust this year found that just one in three children aged eight to 18 read in their spare time (33%) – a 36% decrease from 2005. The survey also indicated a particularly steep drop over the last year among primary school children, and that reading continues to be less popular among boys than girls.

I am highlighting this because we are a school where reading is still pleasurable for our children, and this is mainly thanks to the parents who continue to prioritise reading and recognise its value. Please come and speak to me or any of the teachers if you are looking for book recommendations. We cannot let reading for pleasure disappear.
